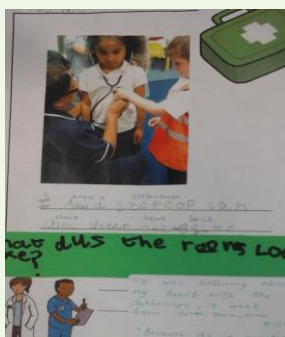

Work of the week

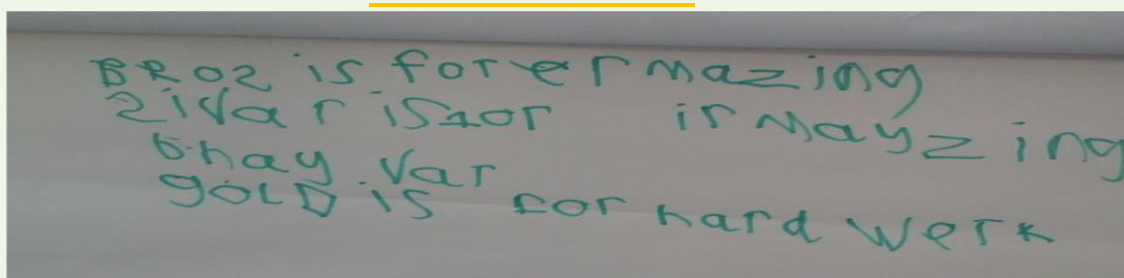
