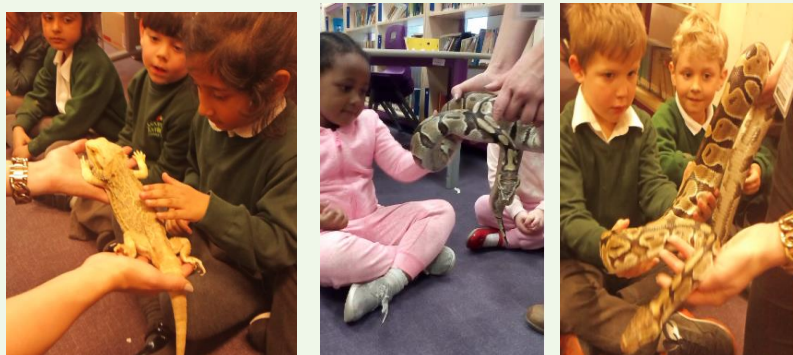


EARLY YEARS NEWS

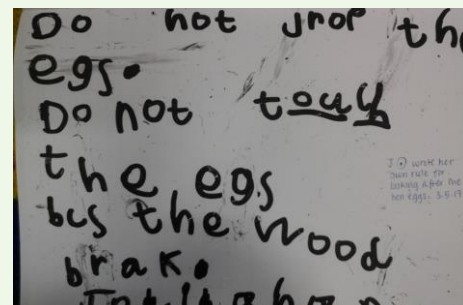
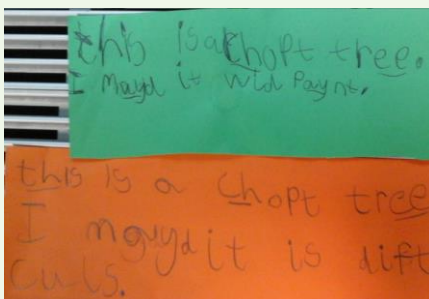
Plea to Parents
