They also inhibit children's educational achievement. All children have the right to feel positive about themselves. And we will do all we can to enable this to happen.

Our 10 Golden Rules

We are gentle - We listen

We don't hurt others - We don't interrupt

We are honest - We are resilient and we try our best

We don't cover up the truth - We don't give up when facing challenges

We are kind and helpful - We look after property and put rubbish in the bin

We don't hurt anybody's feelings - We don't litter or damage things

We take responsibility for our actions - We use our words

We don't blame others - We don't use violence

We are respectful - We look after one another

We don't speak disrespectfully - We are not bystanders

If the Golden Rules are not adhered to then the children will miss out on activities and have time out after being given a verbal warning. Should any children use violence or put any member of staff or pupils in danger then this will result in the child being sent home. The child should be collected within an hour of the phone call received. Poor behaviour will mean a child forfeits their place at Holiday Club.
