



Application for George Tomlinson Nursery

Children can start nursery the term after their third birthday.

If you are interested in registering your child for the nursery you will need to do the following;

- Find out about our Nursery by looking on the school website or arranging a visit with the school office.
- Collect a pack from the school office.
- Fill in the admissions form and parent/child Nursery information form.
- Bring in the correct documents for the school office to photocopy; Child's birth certificate, and passport, both parents photo ID, two proofs of address from the last three months and the children's red NHS book.
- You can check if you are eligible for a two year old place or for the 30 hours provision by going on line to www.childcarechoices.gov.uk/ however it is best to check this information near to the time when your child is due to start nursery or the code will run out and will need to be rechecked.
- Once you have filled in all your details and the office has all your forms you will need to wait till the term before your child is due to start nursery. Parents will be contacted a few weeks before the half term, for example, September places parents will be notified in May and for January places parents will be notified in October. You will receive a letter asking if you still want the nursery place which you will need to confirm by returning a slip to the school.
- You will be asked to attend some workshops and stay and play sessions with your child during the term before and a home visit will be arranged for just before your child is due to start.
