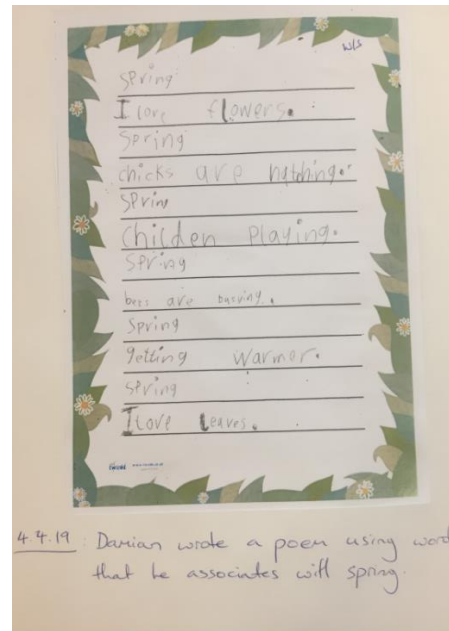

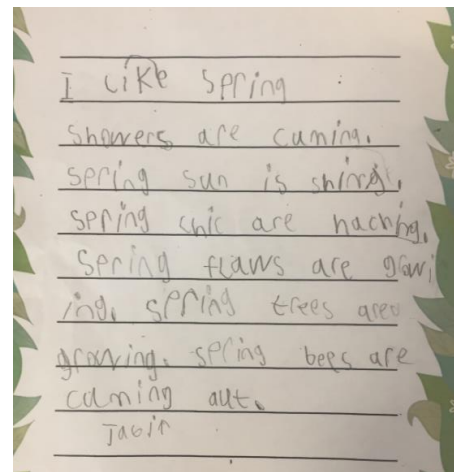
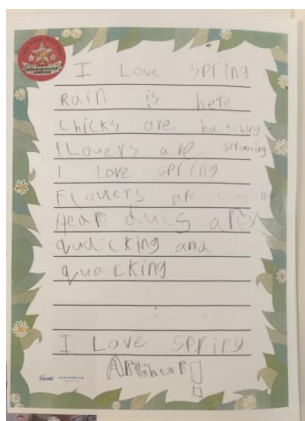


Year 1

WEEKLY DATES

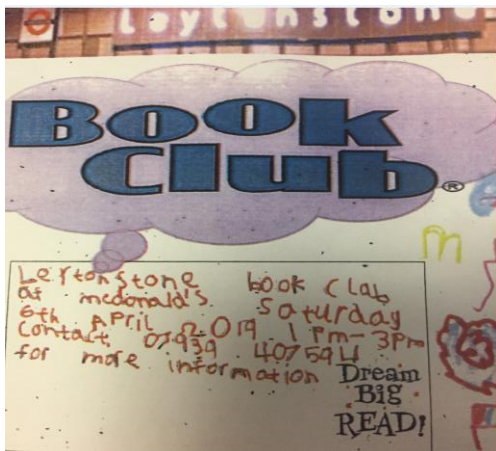
Monday mornings - 9.00am - English conversation Classes – these classes are free to all members of the school community.
