# Our Additional Curriculum

## Personal development, life skills and employability programmes



Our aim is to ensure that all our students leave Frederick Bremer with the qualifications and skills they need to live happy and independent lives. To support this we offer;

- Morning 'check-in' to assist with organization and alleviate anxiety
- Rapid reader interventions twice weekly.
- Read Write Fresh Start 4 afternoons a week after school.
- Weekly meetings with a dedicated keyworker.
- A half-termly action plan that supports students life skills
- Year 9 BTEC Sport course
- KS4 Business/Food/Retail BTEC course



# A broad balanced curriculum

## Our specialist Interventions

Our students are supported with tailored provision which can include;

- Enrichment clubs: football creative cooking gardening
- Weekly sessions with a qualified speech and language therapist or trained teaching assistant
- Social Story groups where students can rehearse new situations and manage their anxiety.
- Interventions in core subjects for GCSE's

## Inclusion in Whole School Opportunities

We are committed to ensuring that our ASC students experience equal opportunities across the school – we are dedicated in providing;

- Inclusion in KS4 Leadership Programme
- Representation on trips and visits including journeys abroad
- Representation on School Council and Prefect Programme
- Contribution to pupil voice and feedback about learning experiences

The ASC provision at Frederick Bremer provides an environment where all students feel included and accepted so that they are empowered to participate and make excellent progress alongside their peers.

## Our offer

Our students are entitled to the following provision;

- Daily check in with a dedicated keyworker
- Supported break and lunch time activities
- In class support from a Teaching Assistant where appropriate
- Individual personal development curriculum to enhance life skills
- Weekly speech and language therapy
- Specialist interventions such as 'Social Stories'
- Daily Clubs incl. Cartoon, Cooking and Lego Therapy
- Additional employability curriculum where appropriate
- Priority given to inclusion in whole school visits, events and clubs
- Guaranteed representation in whole school leadership opportunities and school council
